Application and Relevance

This course applies to a wide range of settings where emergencies involving cardiac arrest may occur. It is relevant for people working in education, aged and community care, sport, travel & tourism, hospitality, industry enterprises as well as in home or other environments.

Duration

2 hours classroom training and assessment.

Course Content

This course provides the skills and knowledge to be able to handle cardiac emergency situations. It includes:

- + Introduction to first aid principles
- + Assessing a cardiac emergency situation
- + Airway and breathing management
- + Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation techniques
- + Performing chest compressions
- + Administering rescue breaths

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisite units. Participants should have numeracy and literacy skills equivalent to level 2 of the National Reporting System.

Assessment Methods

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including demonstration of practical skills and written and oral questions relating to underpinning knowledge.

Award Issued

A nationally-recognised Statement of Attainment will be issued to all successful participants.
