



Occupational First Aid (Level 3 – Advanced First Aid)

Application and Relevance

This course applies to a range of industries where qualified first aiders need to be available for each work shift. The course takes into account the hazards and likely injuries for the particular industry. It is relevant for personnel who are the designated first aiders, particularly those working in manufacturing, construction or mining or any occupation involving hazardous work.

Duration

3 days (21 hours) classroom training and assessment OR
2 days (14 hours) classroom training and assessment with either online or workbook theory learning and assessment completed prior.

Course Content

This course deals with the provision of advanced first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance, and provision of support to other providers. It includes the content of HLTFA404B Apply Advanced Resuscitation Techniques. It also addresses the establishment and maintenance of facilities to enable or facilitate the provision of appropriate first aid in the workplace. It includes:

- + Maintaining correct WorkCover documentation & Legislative requirements of an Occupational First Aider
- + Undertaking the correct requirements for running a First Aid Centre & correct administration for medications
- + Safe use of medical oxygen equipment and administering Oxygen Therapy and Resuscitation to a casualty
- + First Aid for a casualty suffering Crush Injuries
- + Toxicological hazards and use of Material Safety Data Sheets
- + Assessing the hazards of confined spaces
- + First Aid for casualties suffering from extremes of temperature
- + First Aid for minor wounds using aseptic techniques & applying infection control procedures
- + Safe use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)

Prerequisites

Participants must have current HLTFA301C Apply First Aid before undertaking this course.

Assessment Methods

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including demonstration of practical skills and written and oral questions relating to underpinning knowledge.

Award Issued

A nationally-recognised Statement of Attainment will be issued to all successful participants.
