Application and Relevance

This course applies to a wide range of settings where emergencies involving cardiac arrest may occur.

It is relevant for people working in education, aged and community care, sport, travel & tourism, hospitality, industry enterprises and other environments.

Duration

4 hours classroom training and assessment or
3 hour program for re-accreditation

Course Content

This course provides the skills and knowledge to be able to handle cardiac emergency situations. It includes:

- + Background knowledge of heart structure, function and coronary conditions
- + The Chain of Survival and the importance of early defibrillation
- + Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation techniques
- + The skills required to safely perform defibrillation

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisite units. HLTCPR201B Perform CPR is a prerequisite of Apply Automated External Defibrillation and is included in the course. Participants should have numeracy and literacy skills equivalent to level 2 of the National Reporting System.

Assessment Methods

Progressive assessment throughout the course, including demonstration of practical skills and written and oral questions relating to underpinning knowledge.

Award Issued

A nationally-recognised Statement of Attainment will be issued to all successful participants.
